<p>Language requirements</p>	<p>At present, all courses are taught in Spanish. B1 level is required. Accepted certificates: DELE, CELU, ACTFL.</p> <p>UNC provides a Spanish language course (PECLA) for students that do not have the required level or accepted certificates. This course has an extra cost of USD 200 (US dollars).</p>

<p>Credit and grade system</p>	<p>UNC grade system is based on a 0 to 10 scale, where 10 is the highest and 4 is the minimum for approval. Conditions for approval (partial exams, final integrative exam, practical work, reports, projects, etc.) are specific for each course.</p> <p>The RTF credit system applied at FCEfyN-UNC is based on the following equivalence: 1 RTF credit = 30 hours of total work. 1 full semester represents approximately 30 RTF credits.</p>
<p>Student services</p>	<p>UNC does not have housing services.
